



Some have a history of trauma, abuse, or neglect. Others have made mistakes and are involved or are at high risk for involvement in the juvenile justice system.

OUR PROGRAMS MEET CRITICAL NEEDS IN OUR COMMUNITY

Haven House has three main focus areas: youth homelessness, mental health, and diversion



A HAVEN FOR SAFETY

WRENN HOUSE
The only homeless, runaway and crisis intervention shelter for youth ages 10-17 in the Triangle.

STREET OUTREACH
Provides basic need items and outreach services for youth ages 16-24 experiencing homelessness.

TRANSITION IN PLACE
Helps homeless youth ages 18-23 move into transitional housing and build independent living skills.



A HAVEN FOR SUPPORT

JUVENILE ASSESSMENT TEAM
Provides clinical assessments and referrals to services for court-involved youth.

MULTI-SYSTEMIC THERAPY
Mental health program that supports the family unit to help youth at high risk for out-of-home placement.

OUTPATIENT THERAPY
Clinical support, including individual and family therapy, for youth ages 7-24.



A HAVEN FOR GROWTH

SECOND ROUND
Helps youth ages 12-21 improve well-being and build skills through boxing and exercise.

RESTITUTION AND COMMUNITY SERVICE
Provides youth with supervised community service hours and the opportunity to earn restitution to benefit victims.

JUVENILE DIVERSION PROGRAMS
School and community-based programs working with youth with no prior juvenile justice involvement who are facing challenges. Goal is to prevent future court involvement.
